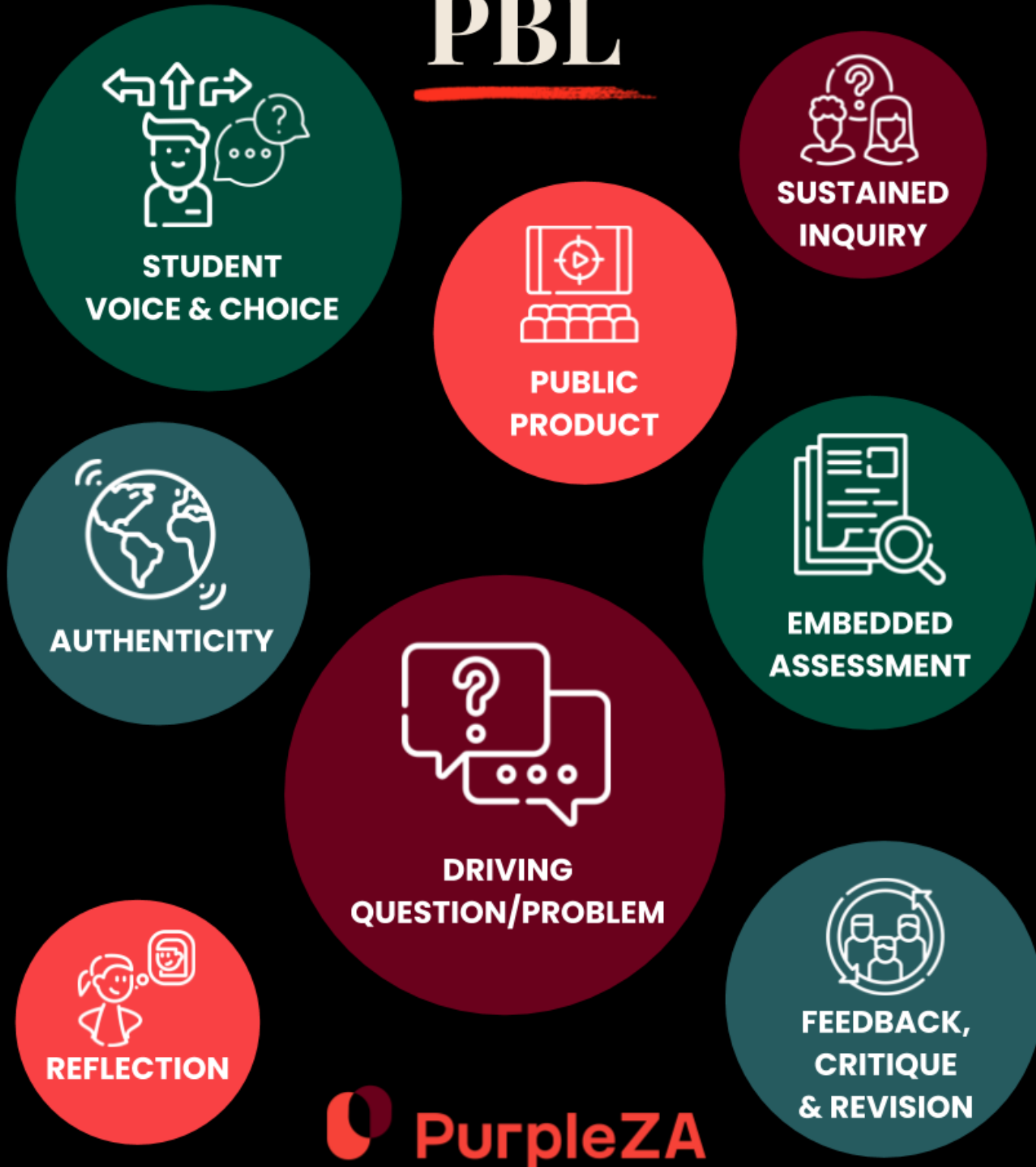

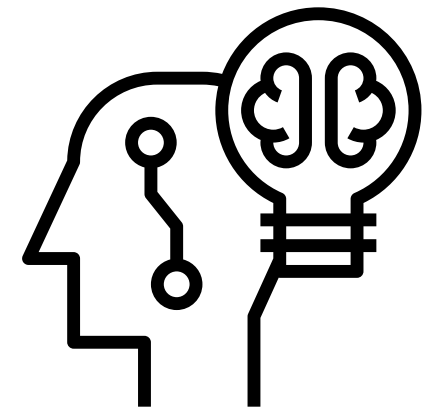


Reflections on Project-based Learning

- **What questions do you have after being on this journey... How would you go about answering them?**

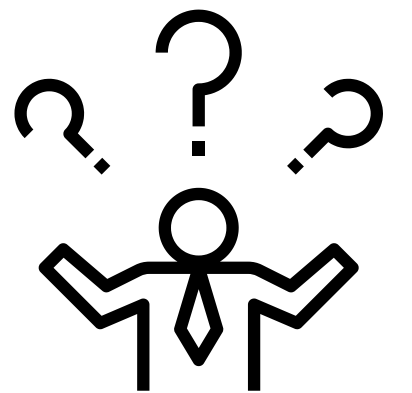
